We are looking for two volunteer Trustees to join the Federation of Westminster Special Schools Charity Fund. We are a small independent organisation registered with the Charity Commission, since 2017. Our aim is to raise funds to advance the learning of the children and young people who attend **College Park** and **QEII Jubilee** special schools.

Our recent projects have included a new play area for QEII and facilitating provision of specialist scooters. Two new minibuses are being supplied to QEII and we have funded additional equipment at College Park. The extra equipment and facilities have a huge positive impact on the lives and development of our children with special educational needs. We are very pleased to have been able to do this and we want to continue into the future. To help support this, we are on the look out for two new Trustees who will help us continue these kinds of initiatives.

Requirements of the new trustee roles are:

We are looking for one person who has experience of raising funds and the other should have finance knowledge. Both roles are unpaid.

These skills will complement the skills we currently have and help us to move on to the next stage in our development.

The Trustees meet three times a year via Zoom usually during the school day. However, you would be very welcome to visit both schools.

Unfortunately, our constitution does not allow Trustees to be staff working at the Federation schools or the parents/carers of children at one of the Federation schools there but everyone else is welcome to apply.
